ON ARRIVAL PLEASE REPORT TO FRONT RECEPTION FOR EACH LESSON

1. Swim lesson payments are non-refundable.
2. Solid Energy Centre reserves the right to change its prices at any time. Changes will be made with no less than one month notice via notices inside the Buller Electricity Aquatic Centre.
3. Payment of fees
 - a. A \$10 non-refundable booking fee is required before students are placed into any class
 - b. The balance is required in full before the start of Week 2.
 - c. Fees are set by the number of lessons in the term or programme
4. Absenteeism
 - a. Parents/Supervisors (Students) are to contact the centre if student is absent
 - b. In the event of sickness stopping students participating, please present a medical certificate to allow a credit to be issued. Credit methods are;
 - Credit for the following term or programme lessons: or
 - Voucher/s for casual swimming admission.
 - c. No credit will be issued for any other reason.
5. All children under 8 years of age must be Actively Supervised by a caregiver 16 years or over at all times. All children under 3 years of age must be Actively Supervised by a caregiver 16 years or over at all times **in the water**.
6. Students are advised not to swim before their lessons, as this dramatically affects their learning capability. Students may practice for 10 minutes after their lesson at no extra charge. Any extra time will incur a normal entry fee.
7. All classes will be run using ASTA levels 1-5 starting promptly on time. Ensure your child is ready to get in the pool – hair, cap and goggles all ready. The use of goggles is up to the individual, but if they are worn they must stay on.
8. We encourage parents to come and watch their child's lesson but we request that you do not talk to your child or approach the side of the pool while the lesson is in progress, unless the swim instructor asks you to.
9. In the interests of safety, hygiene, maintenance & enjoyment for all Aquatic Centre users, please abide by the following;
 - a. Please walk at all times
 - b. Glass is not permitted in the aquatics hall
 - c. Appropriate, clean swimwear to be worn at all times. (All babies/toddlers must wear snug fitting togs or little swimmers, T-shirts, underwear, street wear, shorts below the knee are not permitted)
 - d. In the interest of health, please do not enter the water if you have had any form of stomach illness in the last 10 days
 - e. Make use of our equipment, but do so in an appropriate and safe manner
 - f. Competitive swimming is encouraged, however please use respectful language, tones, behaviour & gestures at all times
 - g. BYO food and beverage (no alcohol or glass) is encouraged, however please use the supplied tables and rubbish tins
 - h. Caution in shallow water – no dive bombs, jumping, rough play or shoulder rides
 - i. All care, but no responsibility with personal property
10. I understand and agree to the terms and conditions of the Solid Energy Centre. I am aware of the risks of participation activities involving physical exertion, I accept those risks on behalf of my child and I am willing to participate in such activities.
